

Dental Assisting

The Dental Assisting program prepares students to become members of the dental health care team. The course includes theory with demonstrations and classroom instruction. Students receive supervised experience performing procedures using study models, mannequins, and other simulated methods. Students receive three months of supervised experience in the clinical setting performing procedures on dental patients in a dental office.

The Dental Assisting program is accredited by the Commission on Dental Accreditation which allows graduates to be eligible to sit for the Dental Assisting National Board exam.

General Admissions Requirements

- Complete the **Free Application For Federal Student Aid (FAFSA)** online – the website is www.fafsa.ed.gov and our school code is 004025
- Complete the **Application for Enrollment** form online at <https://apply.tbr.edu/?tcat=knoxville>
- Provide **official, sealed high school transcript** or equivalent
IMPORTANT: If you have foreign transcripts you will need to provide an English translated version of your transcript and have your education evaluated through the National Association of Credential Evaluation Services. Please visit their website at www.naces.org for more information.

Dental Assisting Program Specific Admission:

- Student must be **18 years of age** by the start of class.
- Provide current **CPR** card certification from American Heart Association in BLS for Healthcare Providers which covers basic life support in infant, child, adult, choking and AED.
- Take and pass the **HESI Exam**. Exam is over Math and Reading Comprehension the cost is \$34.00. Passing scores are 50 in math and 70 in reading Exam..
***ACT EXEMPTION** – If you are under the age of 21 and have scored a 19 or above on BOTH the Reading and Math sections of the ACT (Not the composite score) you do not have to take the HESI. You must bring in your test results with a photo ID. A score of 19 or above in both sections is required.*
