Required Qualifications: Candidates must have a high school diploma/equivalent and Technical Diploma. Must possess competencies as combination welder and be knowledgeable of ASME code requirements. Must be a good communicator with effective verbal and written skills and be able to organize and provide theoretical and practical instructional activities to enable students to become AWS Certified. Computer skills required.

Preferred Qualifications: Associate Degree preferred. Strong candidates will possess American Welding Society (AWS), Certified Welding Educator (CWE) or Certified Welding Inspector (CWI).

General Duties: The welding instructor is responsible for teaching all phases of the program to include gas metal are (MIG), tungsten inert gas (TIG), shielded metal arc (stick welding), oxyacetylene fusion (gas), inner shield welding, flux core welding, flame cutting, brazing and soldering. Candidate must be able to provide related instruction in metallurgy, blueprint reading, welding symbols, fitting and fabrication. Physically able to lift, stoop, stand and walk to demonstrate and perform all job duties required. Must monitor and evaluate student progress; accurately maintain program and student records. Must maintain an active advisory committee and communicate with business and industry on a regular basis. Other duties include curriculum development and updates, student record keeping, student recruitment, placement and follow-up. Continue personal training and professional development to stay abreast of changes in the industry.
