The Pipefitting and Plumbing Technology program is designed to introduce the student to various techniques used in the pipefitting plumbing trade: pipe fabrication and installation, blueprint reading and isometric drawings, measurement techniques, hand and power tools, cutting and prepping pipe, using a cutting torch, threading pipe, grooving, soldering, brazing, solvent joining pipes and installing valves.
